

SETTING UP YOUR FACEBOOK PAGE: FACEBOOK GROUP VS PAGE

Set up your club's Facebook presence as a Facebook

PAGE

(not a group)







Choose Cause or Community















Make sure your Page name includes the name of your Club





SETTING UP YOUR FACEBOOK PAGE: ABOUT SECTION

- Give a brief overview of your club, including:
- Name of club
- Meeting location and times
- Include your website address on the first line






Be sure to shorten the link to your club's page so it's easy to share!

Create a Custom URL (Link) for your page at set up or go to

Facebook.com/UserName

TIP: Since your FB page URL has to be all one word with no spaces, capitalize first letter of each word so it's easy to read.






SETTING UP YOUR FACEBOOK PAGE: PROFILE PICTURE


Profile picture needs to look good as a small square

- Easily identifiable, e.g.
 Rotary emblem
- Not likely to change regularly





You can skip steps 3 & 4!

- Cover photos can showcase your club members and activities
- Tip: Complete the photo description and include your club's website address for people who click your cover photo





POSTING ON FACEBOOK

- Post about your individual members
- Post about your club meetings, events and projects
- Share from the District's and Rotary
 International's FB pages to your club's page



POSTING ON FACEBOOK: PHOTOS

- Share candid, action photos
- Happy people...and lots of them!
- Tell a story
- Showcase your members & achievements
- Bragging is a socially acceptable behavior on Facebook!

ENCOURAGING CLUB BUY-IN & PARTICIPATION

- Encourage members to LIKE your club page
- Be clear about objectives: awareness & marketing
- Feature members on your page
- Encourage members to post about Rotary on their own profiles
- Encourage members to post on your club page
- Show members how to TAG your club page
- Post at least 3 times per week to keep page active
